



After the readings and the homily (about 55 minutes!), Phillip was called forward for his ordination. Fr. Next, we prayed the Litany of the Saints, asking that God would pour out God's blessings upon Phillip. While everyone else knelt, Phillip prostrated himself.












After the Litany of Saints, Bishop Telesphor laid hands on Phillip in silence.





The Bishop then prayed the prayer of consecration as Phillip knelt before him.


