We rented 2 trucks – both 26'. Dan Mahoney has again excelled with his position as Transportation Director and handled the rentals. Dan Mahoney and Dan Pontzer drove the trucks up to St. Gregory's. Dan Pontzer donated his time, the rental and the gas money for his truck. He lives close to the UHaul center and walks over to meet Dan to pick up the truck. The trucks pulled out at 12 noon. All the families were accounted for this year, although a few gifts were dropped off at the office at the masses this weekend. This happens when someone takes a slip off and doesn't sign up on the sheets. I write out another slip and put it on the board as I want to make sure all the kids have been provided for. Dan Mahoney drove the items up to St. Gregory's on Monday morning. Plenty of time before Christmas.

The Boy Scouts were invaluable with their enthusiasm and strong backs. They also accompanied us to St. Gregory's to unload and stack the boxes in the Senior Center.

Spalding High School delivered their items on Thursday, 14 December and they were stacked in the hall until Saturday. All toys and gifts not placed with families were given to Gloria Williams for her distribution.

A check for \$400 was sent the first week in December to Bethany United Methodist church for their Women in Prison ministry.

We provided for 40 nursing home residents at North Arundel Convalescent Home. Those items are taken directly to the rehabilitation center for distribution at their annual Christmas party. A few people took off slips without signing up on the sheet and I had to put the name up on the board again. One person brought their nursing home resident gift to St. B's on Saturday and Dan Mahoney took it to the Nursing Home for their party that evening. There will be a new Activities Director at the rehab center next year.
