CAMP GLOW

Provides camping experiences for retarded children and adults.

OUR DAILY BREAD \$300

Provides a hot meal for over 600 per day in Baltimore,7 days a week.

TECHNO-SERVE \$300

Training & technical assistance to small agricultural cooperatives helps poor African and Latin American families produce food & income to become self-reliant & independent.

ARUNDEL HOSPICE \$ 100

Cares for the terminally ill and their families through a team of professionals & volunteers.

<u>CHAPLIN-BALTIMORE CITY JAIL</u> \$ 100

To help provide personal care items to 317 women inmates in Baltimore City Jail.

MARYLAND FOOD COMMITTEE \$ 300

Only statewide anti-hunger organization funding feeding programs across the state, working towards the end of hunger in MD.

BROWN MEMORIAL-PEACE COMMISSION/HEALTH PROMOTION \$ 400

Two members of Brown Memorial are living in El Salvador & teaching health care to the people. Church recently purchased a truck so they would not have to walk to the widely separated houses after getting off the bus.

BREAD FOR THE WORLD \$ 200

Lobbies Congress on behalf of poor and hungry people and supports research and educational efforts to relieve world hunger.

BELLO MACHRE \$ 200

Monies go to help provide homes and independent living opportunities for mentally retarded persons of all ages.

COVENANT HOUSE \$ 250

Provides crisis care and long-term support to 25,000 runaways and homeless youths annually. Also operates a national crisis hotline.

THE MID-TOWN CHURCHES COMMUNITY ASSN. INC \$ 300

Operates the Extra Care Homeless Shelter for men, women and families. Also has facilities for the homeless who when released from the hospital and need some convalescent care. Recently obtained another building that needs a new roof, waterproofing & a sprinkler system.

ARUNDEL HABITAT FOR HUMANITY \$ 100

Ecumenical Christian organization which builds houses with low-income families of Anne Arundel County selling them at no profit and charging no interest on mortgage.

ST. AMBROSE HOUSING AID CENTER \$ 300

Monies are used to support a Mortgage Assistance Program designed to prevent people who are temporarily out of work from defaulting on their mortgages and a Homesharing Program which matches elderly widow(ers) living alone to people who need affordable shelter.

ARCHBISHOP OF DURBAN \$ 200

Monies to be used to inoculate South African children against killing and crippling diseases.

REFUGEE VOICES \$ 200

Monies support this groups efforts to raise the consciousness among U.S. citizens about the plight of refugees worldwide.

ST. VERONICA \$ 250

Money will help enable the parish in the Cherry Hill community in South Baltimore to purchase a van that will be used in outreach.

CLINIC IN TUTWEILDER, MISS

\$ 300

Monies will help this clinic in a very poor area to provide basic health care to people who currently don't have any.
